One-day-meeting is to promote scientific interaction between the students and scientists with a shared interest in the field of "Recent Advances in Chemical and Pharmaceutical Sciences". The poster symposium offers a chance for PhD, MS & MSc students to showcase their research results to their peers, leading academic and R&D chemists. The poster-session will proceed with keynote lecture by distinguished scientist.

There will be a **First and two Runner ups prizes for the <u>best posters</u>**. **Certificates** will be issued to all the registered participants.

What is Poster Session?

The poster sessions provide an informal forum to report the outcome of an innovative project(s). It is a visual presentation, on a **1 m X 1 m** poster-board, outlining a piece of research. It is expected to be in a form that is easily assimilated and stimulates interest and discussion. The aim is a fruitful exchange of ideas between the presenter and the people reading the poster. It should tell a story. As in any research presentation, the outline includes a statement of the problem, a description of the method, a summary of the work, and then a presentation of results. Conclusions should leave the reader with a clear message to take away. Poster presentation is more lively than a lecture.

Guidelines for the submission of abstract of the poster

Abstract should be written in Times New Roman font (12 pt; single space) and should not exceed 300 words.

Young Investigator Oral Presentations (duration 5 min.)

Those who are interested to give oral presentation (limited numbers) can submit their abstract along with the presenter's name. Final selection for oral presentation is based on the importance of the research work and will be intimated to the candidates in advance.

Guidelines for poster

Title; Author Name(s): Indicate Main Author with asterisk (*); Address of the Institute / University/College & Department; Abstract Text; Results & Discussion; Conclusions; Schemes/Figures; References if any; E-mail address; Poster size: should be 1 sq.m or smaller.

NOTE: Any poster not presenting original work will not be considered.
